Does your congregation have a mission plan?

Is it in alignment with the overarching mission of the United Methodist Church? (para 120, Book of Discipline)

Paragraph 120 states that the mission of the church is to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

If you do not have a mission plan, we expect you will develop one.

In order to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world our bishop is asking every congregation and each individual member to develop a disciple plan.

To answer why we are making Disciples of Jesus Christ, Bishop King is asking us to embrace the vision **Growing a Christlike World**.

The way we grow a Christlike world is by making disciples of Jesus Christ. To make disciples you need to make a **disciple plan**.

The disciple plan should include 10 timeless values and they are: Sabbath, Scripture, Stewardship, Lord's Supper, Baptism, Fasting, Justice, Fellowship, Evangelism/Witness and Prayer.

We are aware that some of us are further along in our disciple making process than others.

Let's commit anew to work together to fulfill the great commission in Matthew 28:19. We plan to work together lovingly and supportively as we grow into making disciples of Jesus Christ.
