



South Georgia needs a new home

By now you probably know that our Conference is raising funds to build a “home.” We have been in rented offices ever since we first became an Episcopal Area in 1988. Renting was fine when we were starting out, but it gets expensive over 25-30+ years. Now is the time to build a home for our Conference.

The Conference is currently paying more than \$53,000/year to rent space for the Episcopal Office and Administrative Services Office in Macon, and these spaces have become overcrowded and no longer adequately meet the needs of the Conference. The new Conference Center, which will be located on the grounds of Wesleyan College in Macon, will allow several conference offices to work under the same roof instead of being dispersed in multiple office buildings. This will optimize work flow and delivery of services to the conference and will be less expensive to operate.

We have already raised \$1.4 million of the expected \$2.2 million cost of the new Conference Center. **We are asking 5,000 South Georgia United Methodists to donate \$100 each to help us reach the final stage of fundraising.** Already we have more than 800 donations totaling \$100,000.
