

The South Georgia Annual Conference adopted a **Safe Sanctuaries** policy in June 2007. According to this policy, each local church will conduct the screening process for the adult counselors or chaperones that accompany the participants from their church. After July 1, 2008, each church is required to certify to the Camp Director that their chaperones meet the minimum screening standards and will practice the prevention procedures outlined in the policy prior to that volunteer's service at the event.
