S3 Requirements for Groups:

- ❖ Complete applications for individual and peer group project participation.
- ❖ Develop an outline for a structured, intentional peer group learning experience which will be refined at the S3 project orientation. This plan is created collaboratively with your peer group and in conversation with S3 project team. Each peer group final plan must be approved by the S3 Project Team prior to receiving grant funding.
- ❖ Implement the learning experience, completing project reflections in a timely way.
- ❖ Meet together five times per year during the project.
- ❖ Attend the Annual S3 Project Retreat at Epworth By The Sea while your group is a part of the project. **2018 Dates are September 17-19.** (The S3 Project funding, along with seed money from your local church CEU budget, covers cost of program, double room and most meals). Each participant is responsible for incidental expenses and travel.
- ❖ Maintain financial records of project expenditures funded by the S3 Project.
- ❖ Complete final written evaluation/reflections.

Instructions for completing application

There are two applications forms: an individual application required of all participants and a peer learning group project application required of each group:

- ❖ In the Group Application you are asked to describe your group's learning experience. It is expected that descriptions of learning projects made in the initial application may change or expand as the group works on their project plan during the annual retreat.
- ❖ Complete all questions, noting the word limits indicated. Please be concise.
- ❖ Applications should word processed, saved as a Word file or .PDF and sent to jasbell@vinevillemethodist.org
- ❖ Print and sign individual applications. The Group Project application should be signed by the primary contact person.
- ❖ The original, signed documents must be submitted electronically, or postmarked no later than July 1, to:

The S3 program requires that the local church provide \$150 per year to the S3 program for two years (\$150 in August 2018 and \$150 in August 2019.)
